Consumer Watering Instructions **Water thoroughly when top 1 inch (3cm) of soil is dry.**

Bloom Time **Blooms Spring to Summer**

Height **20-27 inches (51-69 cm)**

Garden Spacing **24 inches (61 cm)**

### DESCRIPTION

Glossy, dark green foliage with bright yellow flowers; very open and airy habit. Very early to bloom in the spring.

### CONSUMER APPEAL

- Very easy to care for and prolific bloomer, no deadheading required.
- Attractive to pollinators and resistant to deer.
- Can be used as a short-lived cut flower.

### GARDEN ATTRIBUTES

- Good intermixed with perennial borders.
- Tolerates poor soils.
- Can perennialize in warmer climates (zones 8-11).
