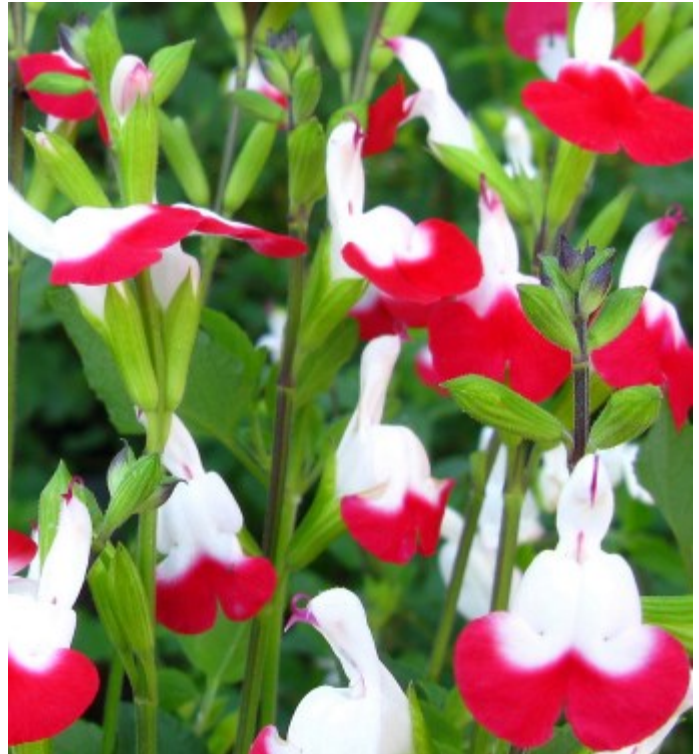

KEY INFORMATION

Primary Common Name	Salvia
Consumer Watering Instructions	Water thoroughly when top 1 inch (3cm) of soil is dry.
Bloom Time	Blooms Summer.
Exposure	Full Sun to Part Sun
Height	3-6 inches (8-15 cm)
Garden Spacing	1.5-2 inches (4-5 cm)

DESCRIPTION

Landscape salvia that works well as a wispy component sandwiched in front of shrubs but behind shorter landscape annuals.

CONSUMER APPEAL

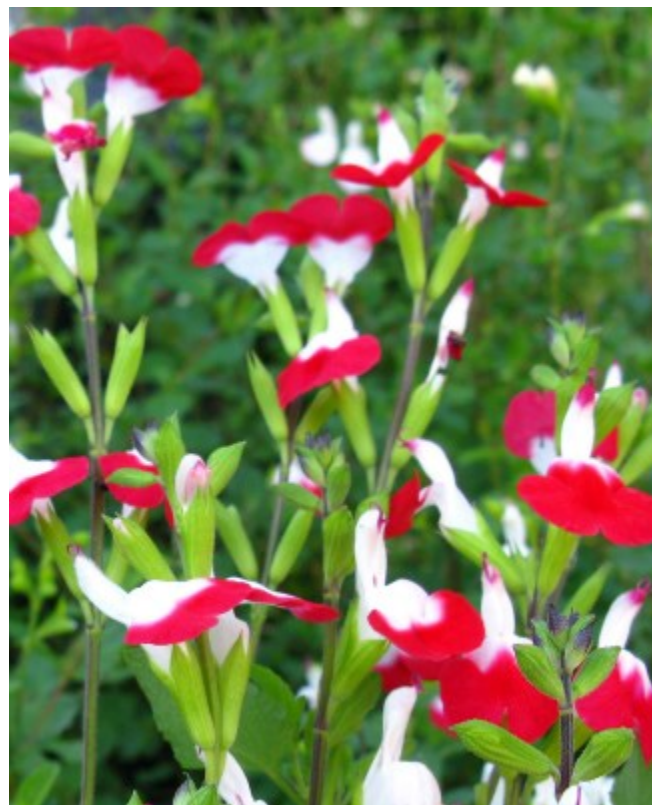
- A good season-extending summer sale item. Market the heat tolerance of this plant combined with its pollinator performance.
- A strong butterfly and hummingbird magnet. Deer resistant.
- Fragrant foliage and semi-fragrant flowers work well in cut floral arrangements.

GARDEN ATTRIBUTES

- Ideally utilized in the landscape but can be grown in large containers as the upright accent component.
- Prefers well drained soil but is tolerant of clay soils if not overwatered.
- Can be overwintered in zone 8-11.
