Primary Common Name	Cape Primrose
Consumer Watering Instructions	Keep soil evenly moist, but not saturated.
Bloom Time	Blooms Summer
Exposure	Part Shade to Full Shade
Height	6-12 inches (15-30 cm)
Garden Spacing	12-18 inches (30-46 cm)

DESCRIPTION

Velvety textured foliage with whirls of small purple flowers set above the plant.
