Primary Common Name	Dwarf Morning Glories
Consumer Watering Instructions	Water thoroughly when top 1 inch (3cm) of soil is dry.
Bloom Time	Blooms Summer
Exposure	Full Sun to Part Shade
Height	10 inches (25 cm)
Garden Spacing	15 inches (38 cm)

DESCRIPTION

A non-vining morning glory that creates mounds of sprawling foliage topped with periwinkle-blue flowers.



CONSUMER APPEAL

- Somewhat novel and rare, market this as an unusual easy-to-grow annual to spice up the landscape.

GARDEN ATTRIBUTES

- Good as a groundcover in mass plantings or cascading over garden walls. Works well in hanging baskets due to its spreading trailing habit.
- Tolerant of a wide range of soil conditions but will thrive in fertile, well drained soils.
- Can be overwintered in zones 9-11.
