DESCRIPTION	

Glechoma is the perfect option for gardeners interested in an alternative to English ivy. It sports the common name of "ground ivy" for its tendency to spread vigorously as a ground cover, but without the risk of vertical grown onto other plants or structures.

CONSUMER APPEAL

- Although somewhat hidden from sight (designating this plant as foliage interest), the deep lavender blooms of this plant support some bee species.
- Due to its fragrant foliage, deer find this plant unpalatable and avoid it.

GARDEN ATTRIBUTES

- The ideal groundcover or lawn replacement (although not particularly tolerant of foot traffic), this plant is perfect for mass plantings or in containers. Works well under shrubs providing a canvas of textural contrasts.
- Tolerant of most soil conditions, this plant is drought tolerant once established, especially in part shade locations.
- Though not aggressive, this perennial likes to stretch its legs and spread into new territory.

NATIVITY

Originated in Europe and Southwest Asia but has been naturalized across the globe.
