

# TIPS

- Lantanas grow best when fertilized with a blend of nitrate and ammonium-based fertilizers to strike a balance in leaf size, pH levels, and growth habit.
- Cold, wet, conditions hinder growth and increase disease pressures.
- Full sun outdoor production is ideal.
- Saturated media with a high salt content drastically increases plant susceptibility to fungal root rot diseases. Leach regularly to limit salt buildup.
- If not pinched during propagation, pinch 1.5-2 weeks after transplant.
