

• None for YOLO Top cultivars. A 1500-2500ppm B-Nine (85% Daminozide) application may be applied to standard YOLO cultivars. Several applications may be necessary.

TIPS

- Although somewhat unorthodox, soft-pinching cuttings upon stick can reduce flowering in propagation, promote uniformity, promote better branching, and reduce rooting times. Pinching early forces the plant into a vegetative strategy making it easier to bul
- Once established, plants should be grown under high light and cool temperatures to prevent stretch and build the plant chassis.
- Although tolerant of salts in the landscape, Lobularia plugs can be sensitive to fertilizer salts, especially during the propagation phase of growth. Ensure that soluble salts do not build up in the media.
- A preventative fungicide application may be applied to prevent root rot diseases and dampingoff syndromes.
- Botrytis can be prevented with a 4-6 ppm Pageant spray.

TIPS

- Avoid overhead irrigation as this will increase disease pressure.
- Using a nitrate-based fertilizer containing low quantities of phosphorous will reduce stretch while balancing pH levels.
- Avoid using pesticides that contain copper as a base material.
- Botrytis can be prevented with a 4-6 ppm Pageant spray.

- Excellent pollinator plant attracting butterflies and other beneficial insects.

GARDEN ATTRIBUTES

- Excellent in mixed containers, as a component in the Glossy Confetti Garden® series, as a landscape groundcover, or as a fragrant mounding centerpiece for a patio table.
- Prefers moist, well-drained soil. Very drought tolerant once established.
- Native to the coastal regions of the Mediterranean, sweet alyssum goes dormant during the hot dry Mediterranean summers. Keep YOLO well-watered during the hot dry American summers to prevent death or dormancy.
- Can be overwintered in zones 5-9.
