PRODUCTION

PLANTING

Planting time	January-May
Pot Size	6" (15cm)
Plants per pot	1
Spacing	Can start in a 6pk carrier, but space as leaves begin to touch
Media Type	Media should be well drained
Time to flower	12-16 weeks

FERTILITY

Fertilizer Rate	Light feeder: feed based on EC and pH ranges utilizing a balanced feed w/Ca and Mg
EC Range	1.0mS via SME
pH Range	6.2-6.8

TEMPERATURE

Ave. Day Temperature	72-80°F (22-27°C)
Ave. Night Temperature	54-60°F (12-16°C)

IRRIGATION

Irrigation Frequency	Water early in the day and keep crop as dry as possible. Do not use overhead watering (flower heads must remain dry to avoid botrytis).
Humidity	Keep humidity levels low to avoid botrytis. Proper ventilation is needed especially in the morning to remove moisture/humidity among plants.

LIGHT

Photoperiodic?	Long day for flower production
Light Levels	Insufficient sunlight will cause weak elongated stems and flowers that never mature. Winter production in northern locations isn't recommended due to poor light intensity.

HARVESTING

- Harvesting can be expected 12-16 weeks after planting. Flower should be picked with 90% of the flowers show color as they will not continue to open once picked.
- Remove field heat from flowers prior to boxing. Keep stable climate conditions (variable climate will shorten vase life).

POTENTIAL DISEASES

Botrytis, Sclerotinia, Rhizoctonia, Powdery Mildew, Downy Mildew, Rust

POTENTIAL PESTS

Spider Mite, Cutworm, Caterpillars, Beetles

PGR

- None needed

TIPS

- Only water when the plant shows signs of insufficient water (in general ~3x/week). The plants will absorb water at night and may seem wet/humid in the morning.
- Keep crop dry and use a preventative spray program to avoid botrytis.
