## PGR SUGGESTIONS

- 350ppm Florel (3.9% Ethephon)
- 1500-2000ppm B-Nine (85% Daminozide) as needed prior to pinch



## TIPS

- Dibble three evenly spaced holes per rooting cell. Holes that are too large or deep will cause uneven rooting from lack of stem-to-root medium contact. Once cuttings are stuck, trays should be sent through a water tunnel to seat/seal the cuttings in the dibble holes to ensure quick uniform rooting.
- Petunia and Calibrachoa should receive an acidifying fertilizer to avoid iron deficiency. Five to six days after first roots appear, 350ppm Florel (3.9% Ethephon) spray may be applied to the cuttings followed by an optional second application of 350ppm Florel (3.9% Ethephon) 10 days later.
- One sticker can stick an entire inner-box of one mix. Stick one cultivar at a time to avoid confusion.

- 0.5-1ppm Bonzi (0.4% Paclobutrazol) drench

## TIPS

- A constantly fed complete blend fertilizer is recommended.
- Plant liners upon receipt or within 5 weeks of stick in early season, 4 weeks in later season. Holding liners is detrimental to plant quality.
- No matter the number of liners placed in a container, they should all be placed in the center, not spread out towards the rim of the container. For two or three liners, they should be clustered in the center separated only slightly.
- Use a complete NPK fertilizer such as 20-10-20. Confetti Garden® grown outdoors require additional fertilizer to compensate for outdoor rain.
- Additional pinching during production greatly improves branching and plant form of Confetti Garden® at finish. A light trim/pinch several weeks after transplant is highly suggested. Trimming and manicuring plants early in production produces a fuller, more balanced Confetti Garden®, as opposed to early PGR applications.
