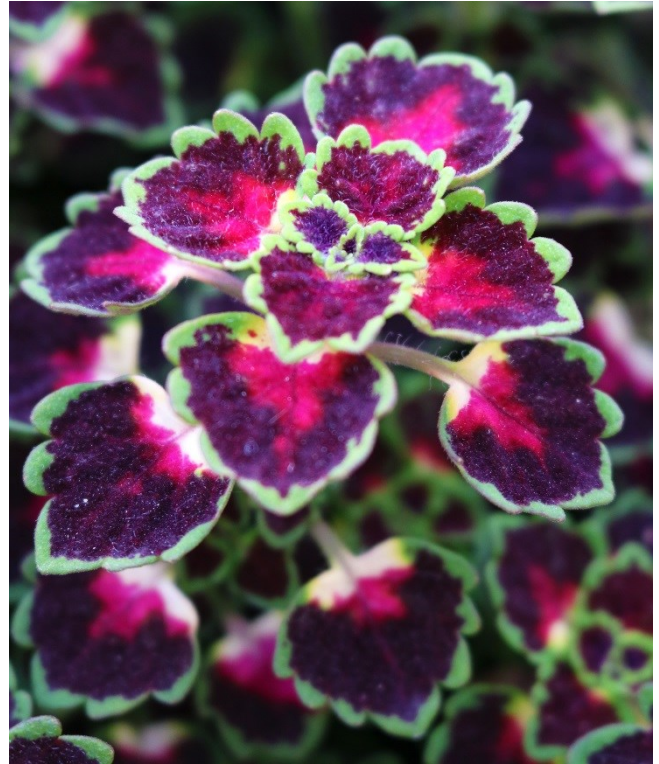

- 100ppm Configure (2% 6-BA Benzyladenine)

TIPS

- Avoid excessive mist to control stretch.
- Florel (3.9% Ethephon) can be used 10 days after stick to promote branching.
- Transplant on time to minimize stress and stretch. Tone in high light.

PGR SUGGESTIONS

- 300ppm Florel (3.9% Ethephon) + 100ppm Configure (2% 6-BA Benzyladenine) as an alternative to mechanical pinching

TIPS

- Grow coleus at temperatures higher than 60°F (16°C) to avoid stretch and poor branching.
- Feed with a balanced fertilizer at a low to moderate rate.
- Avoid overwatering and saturated soil. Allow media to dry between waterings but do not allow plants to wilt.
- Do not overschedule your coleus crop, this will result in additional measures to control growth and diminishes quality.

A well-behaved trailing coleus series with a wide range of colors and matching habit throughout the series.

CONSUMER APPEAL

- Although an excellent standalone item, Great Falls coleus reaches its full potential in Confetti Garden® Safari mixes.
- Resistant to rabbits, deer, and most herbivorous insects.
- Can work nicely as a foliage accent piece in cut floral arrangements.

GARDEN ATTRIBUTES

- Works well in hanging baskets but can be effective as a landscape groundcover as well.
- Prefers fertile, moderately-moist, well drained soils but is tolerant of most soil types.
- Great Falls blooms very late in the season keeping the delightful foliage center stage throughout the growth season.
