### TIPS

- Grow coleus at temperatures higher than 60°F (16°C) to avoid stretch and poor branching.
- Feed with a balanced fertilizer at a low to moderate rate.
- Avoid overwatering and saturated soil. Allow media to dry between waterings but do not allow plants to wilt.
- Do not overschedule your coleus crop, this will result in additional measures to control growth and diminishes quality.
- Some growers have classified 'Main Street Rodeo Drive' as a PGR sensitive cultivar. Any PGR applications to this cultivar should be made at lower dosages at more frequent intervals.

- 300-500ppm Florel (3.9% Ethephon)
- 300ppm Florel (3.9% Ethephon) + 100ppm Configure (2% 6-BA Benzyladenine) as an alternative to mechanical pinching
