PGR SUGGESTIONS

- Cycocel (11.8% Chlormequat) 750-1500ppm as needed

CULTIVAR LIST

TIPS

- Soft pinch, roll the tip out. Avoid hard pinch.
- Use care when sticking to not cover the apical growing point of the cutting by arranging the large leaves in one direction.
- Apply only enough mist to keep the cuttings turgid. Mist may be required both day and night for the first 10-14 days. Once cuttings begin to root, mist should be reduced and completely off by around day 20.
- Between September 21 and March 21, cuttings must receive long photo periods during propagation to prevent premature flowering. Mum lighting from 10pm to 2am or HID supplemental light from sundown to 2 am can be used to provide long days.
- Provide 16hr long days for the first 7 days after unrooted cuttings are stuck.

PGR SUGGESTIONS

- Cycocel (11.8% Chlormequat) at 750ppm spray as needed
- Bonzi (0.4% Paclobutrazol) drenches 0.1-0.25ppm volume calculated drench if needed to hold.

TIPS

- Grow plants under long days to build the chassis. Light levels should not exceed 4000 fc (43,100 lux). A steady environment with little fluctuation in temperature and moisture is important during vegetative growth. Buds that develop during this phase should be removed manually to promote vegetative growth. The plant should be 2/3 the desired finish size before initiating flower.
- Avoid high-phosphorus fertilizers.
- Soft pinch at transplant.

- Better branching, faster response and improved flower quality over other Begonia x hiemalis. Fully decorative flower that sits atop the shiny foliage.
- Passion Red is slightly more compact than the others.

- Boasts a good plant habit, shiny fully decorative flower.
- Resistant to rabbits.
- Large double flowers stand out at retail and with the consumer.

GARDEN ATTRIBUTES

- Ideal for patio containers, but can perform well in some landscapes as well.
- Prefers moist, well drained soils.
- Trailing/mounded habit excellent for containers, baskets or landscape planting.
