- Ethephon (3.9%) at 350-500 ppm can be used for bud removal and branching 14-21 days after stick; do not apply within 6-8 weeks of ship date

TIPS

- Apply a 200 ppm IBA spray (or equivalent product) within 24 hours of sticking to aid root formation.
- Patriot is a comparably vigorous series, but it is very responsive to PGR applications.
- Only mist enough to keep leaves turgid.

TIPS

- Proper sanitation will help control *Botrytis*, *Pythium* and *Rhizoctonia*. Avoid overapplications of mist and fertilizer; this will help control waterborne pathogens and limit the fungus gnat population.
- Consider direct-stick with callused cuttings to reduce overall production time by 1-2 weeks.

- Pelargonium can be overwintered indoors for extended seasonal interest.
