Fertilize Through Mist?	50-75ppm N

EC Range	Moderate: (2.0-3.5 mS via SME)
pH Range	5.4-6.0

CONTAINER SIZE	PLANTS PER POT	TRANSPLANT TO FINISH (WEEKS)
4 in. (10 cm)	1	5-7
6 in. (15 cm)	1	6-9
8 in. (19 cm) and up	1-2	8-11

Fertilizer Rate	150-200 ppm N
EC Range	Moderate: (2.0-3.5 mS via SME)
pH Range	5.6-6.2

TEMPERATURE

Day Temperature	70-80°F (21-27°C)
Night Temperature	60-64°F (15-18°C)

- B-nine (85% Daminozide) 2,000-3,000 ppm

TIPS

- Allow media to dry moderately between watering.
- Lower watering frequency during cool periods
- Pinch to shape
